For instance, Mocha Mousse is an excellent option for a warm and welcoming space in the living room. It can be incorporated into upholstered furniture, such as couches and armchairs, or used to provide depth to accent walls. The colour's sophisticated vibe can be increased by combining it with softer textiles, brass accents and lighter wood tones.

Jay Liu, art director at interior design firm Right Angle Studio, says Mocha Mousse "looks great as a neutral tone to create warm, welcoming spaces". "Consider pairing it with cream-toned artworks, furnishings, or subtle textures like stucco or micro-cement for a sense of visual harmony."
