Like many HDB flats, this four-room resale unit does not have a balcony that can be given to a garden. Yet, Right Angle Studio has found unique ways to smoothly integrate greenery into the home.

"The owners wanted a designated zone for plants and room for their rabbits to roam around," shares Jay Liu from Right Angle Studio. By converting the three-bedroom unit into a one bedder, the designers have been able to insert a 'green corridor' at the entrance comprising a row of louvre suncreens paired with planter boxes. This not only 'opens' up the house further but also draws natural light deeper into the flat. The central console in the living area is another key feature. This customised design is a sofa, work desk and dining table rolled into one, and also comes with an integrated planter.
